

Future Time Clauses

Jakmile dorazím domů, zavolám ti!

Jakmile budu mít čas, “ “ !

Jakmile dokončím dramaturgii, chci ji
zaslat dramatickému souboru.

As soon as ~~I will get~~ home, I will call you. ☹

As soon as I **get** home, I'll call you. ☺

As soon as I **have** time, I'll call you.

When the cashier **ASKS** me if I have a Billa
card, I will say YES!

As soon as I finish my dramatization, I will
send it to a drama club.

Triggers for future time clauses:

As soon as + present simple !!!!!!! (or
předpřítomný in the UK)

After

Until the clock strikes midnight, you may
swing.

Before the semester ends, I will die.

Once

When

While

Unless it rains, we will have a picnic.

If it rains tomorrow, I will take an umbrella.

By the time I **am** 30, I will have 1 baby maybe two we will see how much it hurts the first time.

Whatever happens, we will survive.

I'll take an umbrella **in case** it rains.

~~After we will rehearse, we will.....~~ ☹️

☺️ **After** we rehearse, we will go out for dinner.

As soon as I get up, I will go with a friend of mine to a café.

After I **speak** with her, I will have lunch with my family.

When lunch **is** over, I will have a nap and then start studying.

If I **don't die** studying, I am going to get drunk in the evening.

If I don't die drinking, I will come back to Brno.

US: As soon as I **arrive** home, I'll call you.

UK: As soon as I **have arrived** home, I'll call you.

Learn = naučit se (the result)

Study = učit se (the effort, the attempt)

Man up!

!!!!!!!!!!!!!! Will = wollen/chtit

If you will please sit down, I'll tell the boss that you are here.

If the car won't start, take the bus.
