

Verbs of suggestion

~~I suggest (you) to send the ukulele to the above address.~~ ☹️

<u>Verb</u>	<u>general</u>	<u>for a specific person</u>
Demand	----	(that) s.b + INF. (without to)
Recommend	(doing s.th)	(that) s.b + INF.
Insist	(on doing it)	(that) s.b + INF.
Suggest	(doing it)	(that) s.b + INF.
Prefer	to do it	(that) s.b + INF.
Propose	doing it	(that) s.b + INF.
Request	-----	(that) s.b + INF.

Examples of how to use these verbs for telling a specific person what to do:

We are hungry!

I suggest that **Adelka order** pancakes with chocolate chips.

I request (that) Z NOT send the uk. to me.
I demand (that) he send the uk. to me.
I recommended (that) **Zuzka be** careful with bears.

I suggest that you meet with someone who knows about taxes.
