

Modals in the Past!

Muzu to delat zitra.

I can do that tmrw. 😊

Mohl jsem to delat vcera.

(I could do that yesterday.) 😞

Do = present infinitive

Have done = past infinitive (have + 3. tvar)

I could **HAVE DONE** that yesterday. 😊

+ I could have done it.

- He can't/couldn't have done it.

She may/might have done it.

She must have done it.

She should have read the book for Cultural Politics, her very favourite subject.

I should NOT have played that tournament.

Drink-drunk-drunk

I should have made a birthday card _for_ my grandma.

I could **have slept** all weekend, but I didn't. BAD.

I should **have slept** all weekend.

I would **have slept** all weekend, but the workmen were rebuilding my bedroom, so I couldn't.

I would **have liked to travel** to sunny Greece this weekend, but Natasha didn't approve so I stayed home.

I was able to do that yest.

I could **HAVE DONE** that yest.

I should **have done** that.

He might **have done** that.

He must **have done** that.

He ought to **have done** that.

I could eat the pancakes.

I could have eaten the pancakes.
