Do = present infinitive Have done = past infinitive (have + 3. tvar)

I could HAVE DONE that yesterday. ◎

- + I could have done it.
 - He can't/couldn't have done it.

She may/might have done it. She must have done it.

She should have read the book for Cultural Politics, her very favourite subject.

I should NOT have played that tournament.

Drink-drank-drunk
I should have made a birthday card _for _ my grandma.

I could have slept all weekend, but I didn't. BAD.

I should have slept all weekend.

I would have slept all weekend, but the workmen were rebuilding my bedroom, so I couldn't.

I would have liked to travel to sunny Greece this weekend, but Natasha didn't approve so I stayed home.

I was able to do that yest.
I could HAVE DONE that yest.
I should have done that.
He might have done that.
He must have done that.
He ought to have done that.

I could eat the pancakes.
I could have eaten the pancakes.
