Verbs of suggestion

I suggest (you) to send the ukulele to the above address. ☺

Verb	general	for a specific person
<mark>DRISPRP</mark>		

Demand		(that) s.b	+ INF. (without to)
Recommend	(doing s.th)	(that) s.b	+ INF.
Insist	(on doing it)	(that) s.b	+ INF.
Suggest	(doing it)	(that) s.b	+ INF.
Prefer	to do it	(that) s.b	+ INF.
Request		(that) s.b	+ INF.
Propose	doing it	(that) s.b	+ INF.

BONUS! This construction [(that) s.b + INF.] also works with impersonal constructions like:

It is essential	(that) s.b	+ INF.
It is crucial for DIFA	(that) s.b	+ INF.
It is necessary	(that) s.b	+ INF.

Examples of how to use these verbs for telling a specific person what to do:

We are hungry!

I suggest that chocolate chips.

Klara order pancakes with

I request (that) Zuzka NOT send the uk. to me.

I demand (that) he send the uk. to me. I recommended (that) Zuzka (should) be careful with bears.

I suggest that you meet with someone who knows about taxes.
