<u>Prepositions of place (or activity)</u> [also good with <u>ARRIVE]!</u>

Use IN for rooms or your car.

Use **AT** for all events/activities OR any place *bigger than a room but smaller than the whole town.* Exceptions: in/on a street, in a neighbo(u)rhood, on the beach, in the garden

Use **IN** for the whole town/village or anything larger. Exceptions: on the planet, on an island or peninsula, in the garden

ON the bus, the tram, the train, the boat, the airplane.

**Prepositions of TIME:** 

- AT an hour, at noon, at midnight: At 4 o'clock
- ON a day of the week or a date: On Thursday, on the 12<sup>th</sup> of May
- IN a month or a year, in the morning/afternoon/evening: In May, In 2013
