6 Categories:

I. Use gerund or infinitive, don't worry about it:

Like, begin, start, continue, propose

II. Use just infinitive with to:

Attempt, deserve, expect, threaten, neglect,
manage, fail

III. Use someone (4.pád) plus infinitive with to:

Beg, dare, encourage, invite, persuade,
convince, urge, challenge, allow, permit, force,
oblige

IV. Use someone plus infinitive WITHOUT

to:

Let, make, help

V. Use only gerund (-ing)

Avoid, detest, imagine, keep on, mind, miss,
put off, risk

VI. Use gerund OR infinitive, BUT the
meaning is different!!!!
