

Transitive vs. Intransitive verb pairs! 😊

Transitive verbs need an object

(e.g. Set SOMETHING on the table).

Intransitive verbs cannot take an object.

As in Czech, sometimes the difference is only the interior vowel.

Intransitive : **Lie** (ležet) – **lay** – lain

Transitive: **Lay** (položít) – laid – laid

[Lie (lhat) – lied – lied]

Intransitive: **Sit** (sedět) – sat – sat

Transitive: **Set** (položít/umístit) – set – set

Intransitive: **Rise** (zvýšit se) – rose - risen

Transitive: **Raise** (zvýšit/zvedat) – raised – raised

Intransitive: **Fall** (padat) – **fell** - fallen

Transitive: **Fell** (kácet-) – felled – felled

[Feel (cítit) – felt – felt]
