Prepositions of place (or activity) [also good with ARRIVE]!

Use IN for rooms or your car.

Use **AT** for any place bigger than a room but smaller than the whole town.

Exceptions: in/on a street, in a neighbo(u)rhood, on the beach, in the garden

[BONUS! AT also works for 100% of events/activities.]

Use In for the whole town/village or anything larger. Exceptions: on the planet, on an island or peninsula

ON the bus, the train, the boat, the airplane.

Prepositions of TIME:

AT an hour, at noon, at midnight: At 4 o'clock

ON a day of the week or a date: On Thursday, on the 12th of May

IN a month or a year, in the morning/afternoon/evening:

In May, In 2013
