

WORD ORDER FOR INDIRECT QUESTIONS

Statement: Michal is cheerful.
Question: Is Michal cheerful?
Indirect Q.: I don't know if Michal is cheerful.

Statement: Michal loves fruity Belgian beer.
Question: Does Michal love fruity Belgian beer?
Indirect Q.: I don't know if Michal loves fruity Belgian beer.

Statement: Zuzka lost her pet hamster.
Question: Did Zuzka lose her pet hamster?
Indirect Q.: I didn't know if Zuzka had lost her pet hamster.

Statement: The films are going to cost \$387/438 million.
Question: How much are the films going to cost?
Indirect Q.: The studio didn't know how much the films were going to cost.

Statement: His films will cost \$60-70 million.
Question: How much will his films cost?
Indirect Q.: Wired asked how much his films would cost.
