

VERBS OF SUGGESTION

~~I suggest (you) to send the ukulele to the above address.~~ ☹

Verb general for a specific person

DRISPRP

Demand	----	(that) s.b + INF. (without to)
Recommend	(doing s.th)	(that) s.b + INF.
Insist	(on doing it)	(that) s.b + INF.
Suggest	(doing it)	(that) s.b + INF.
Prefer	to do it	(that) s.b + INF.
Request	-----	(that) s.b + INF.
Propose	doing it	(that) s.b + INF.

BONUS! This construction [(that) s.b + INF.] also works with impersonal constructions like:

It is essential	(that) s.b + INF.
It is crucial for DIFA	(that) s.b + INF.
It is necessary	(that) s.b + INF.

Examples of how to use these verbs for telling a specific person what to do:

We are hungry!

I suggest	(that)	Clair <i>order</i> pancakes with chocolate chips.
I request	(that)	Suzanne NOT <i>order</i> American style pizza.
I demand	(that)	the food delivery <i>arrive</i> within 30 minutes.
I recommended	(that)	the delivery guy (should) <i>use</i> a fast car.
