2) Present	If it rained, If I was a big boy, If I knew that, If he behaved well, If it was the weekend, If she came, Supposing she came,	Yould take an umbrella. I would have a big fast car. I would not go there. I would not do it. I would still be asleep. I would be there. what would you do?

I wish I had more time. (because then I could watch hockey.)

I wish I were/was in Hawaii right now.

BUT!!! For other verbs you must use COULD (for impossibility) or WOULD (for irritation)

I wish I could speak Japanese.

I wish I could spend my holiday on the moon.

I wish I could spend today at home.

I wish Adrian would learn a new joke.

I wish my mother-in-law would move to Turkey.

3) Past

If I had known that,

If he had behaved well,

If it had been the weekend,

If she had come to Brno,

Had she come to Brno,

I would have taken an umbrella.

I would have had a big fast car.

I would not have gone there.

I would not have done it.

I would have slept / I would have stayed in bed.

I would have been there to greet her.

I would have been there to greet her.

I wish it had rained. (because then I would have got clean.)

I wish it hadn't rained.
